Junior Achievement has over 100 local JA Areas across the nation, and together we are the nation's largest organization dedicated to giving young people the knowledge and skills they need to own their economic success, plan for their futures, and make smart academic and economic choices. JA's programs—in the core content areas of work readiness. entrepreneurship and financial literacy—ignite the spark in young people to experience and realize the opportunities and realities of work and life in the 21st century.

### JA SOUTHWEST VIRGINIA

JA of Southwest Virginia was founded in 1957. Our office is located in Roanoke and operates on a \$300,000 budget. A total of 38 board members a wide range of businesses and academic institutions in our region. As of 2022, Keri Garnett serves as the President and CEO.

### **A BRIEF HISTORY**

Junior Achievement was founded in 1919 by Theodore Vail, president of American Telephone & Telegraph; Horace Moses, president of Strathmore Paper Co.; and Senator Murray Crane of Massachusetts. Its first program, JA Company Program®, was offered to high school students on an after-school basis. In 1975. the organization entered the classroom with the introduction of Project Business for the middle grades. Over the last 39 vears. Junior Achievement has expanded its activities and broadened its scope to include in-school and afterschool students.




